Indoor Protocols

A) Jersey; Symptom Checklist; Schedule Pick-up

- Your child's jersey must be collected from the office prior to the first game
- When collecting the jersey you will receive the symptom checklists and a hard copy of the schedule
- If you cannot pick up these items please have someone collect these items on your behalf
- Your child will not be able to play in the first match until the jersey has been collected from the office.

B) Contact Tracing & Symptom Checklist

- BCSC has implemented a dual process for contact tracing and the symptom checklist to ensure we have all individuals' information and processes completed.
- All players/coaching staff/spectators are required to complete contact tracing on the homepage of our website at www.brantfordcitysoccer.ca prior to entering the facility.
- Additionally players will be required to bring a paper copy of the COVID-19 Symptom Checklist to the facility for each game.
- These paper copies must be completed for **BOTH the player and spectator on the same form** presented to the BCSC screener upon arrival at the facility
- If you do not bring the checklist you will be provided one by the BCSC screener and MUST return to your car/vacate the facility until the form is completed (No Exceptions). Upon completion you may re-enter the facility and present the completed form to the BCSC screener.
- Coaches will need to ask each player who brought them to the game and write down the relationship of the spectator to the player in attendance on the game sheet (ex. Grandpa).

C) Arrival/Departure Times & Procedures

- Upon successful screening all attendees will need to use hand sanitizer upon entering the facility
- Players/Coaching staff/spectators are to arrive NO MORE THAN :05 minutes prior to the start of their game. Ex. If the game is scheduled for 6:00pm, Players/parents are not permitted to enter the facility prior to 5:55pm. You will be asked by the screener to return to your vehicle/wait outside until this time.
- Games will start at :05 minutes past the hour. Ex. If the game is scheduled for 6:00pm the game will commence at 6:05pm
- Games are forty (40) minutes in length and there is no half time.
- Games will conclude at :45 minutes past the hour. Ex. If the game is scheduled for 6:00pm it will conclude by 6:45pm
- Players/Coaching staff/spectators are required to depart NO MORE THAN 5 minutes following the games conclusion. Ex. If the game is scheduled for 6:00pm you must vacate the facility by NO LATER THAN 6:50pm.
- There is a designated facility entrance and exit. A map has been attached with a diagram of this for you.

D) Required Equipment/Player's Gear

- A jersey is included in the registration fee for the season
- Players will need to provide their own shin pads. The shin pads must be worn at all times while on the turf
- Players will need to provide their own footwear. One of: Outdoor Soccer Cleats, Indoor Soccer Cleats or Running Shoes must be worn at all times while on the turf
- Players are permitted to wear shorts or long sleeved pants.
- Players will need to wear socks, the socks can be soccer socks or a larger loose fitting pair of regular

socks that fits overtop of the players shin pads.

-Players are permitted to wear a long sleeve shirt underneath their jerseys if they would like.

E) Spectator Limit

-There is a strict limit of one (1) spectator per player. No siblings (please make arrangements for your younger children), grandparents or anyone other than the one (1) person attending with the player is permitted.

-Players in the U5-7 division and the U8-10 divisions will not be permitted to play without a spectator present in the facility and will not be able to stay if the spectator has to leave.

-There is a strict gathering limit in place by the province of fifty (50) individuals. This limit of fifty (50) applies to each area of the complex. Accordingly in the soccer area of the Access Storage Sports Centre there are no more than fifty (50) individuals permitted at any one time. This limit includes all players, coaches, referees, staff and spectators.

-A screener will be present at the facility and will control admittance and ensure that gathering limits are adhered to.

F) Masks

-All players and referees, of all ages, will be required to wear a mask until they enter the field of play area

-Upon departing the field of play area, all players and referees, of all ages, will be required to wear a mask until they have vacated the facility.

-If players/referees need to use a restroom they will need to wear a mask upon exiting the field until they re-enter the field of play area

-All spectators, coaches and staff are required to wear a mask at all times during the sessions and while inside of the Access Storage Sports Centre

-Individuals who choose not to wear a mask will not be permitted entrance to the facility.

-Continued failure to follow the mask rule will result in your child being unable to return to the game. A refund will not be issued if this occurs.

-Players/referees are allowed to wear masks and/or gloves at their own discretion. This PPE must fit securely.
